Dear Valued Members,

My first few months here have been fantastic. I have immensely enjoyed meeting and getting to know many of you and the fantastic staff we have here at Danville Golf Club.

It appears Punxsutawney Phil was right and spring will be arriving early this year. As a result, we will be applying our pre-emergent herbicide application for spring and summer weeds a couple weeks earlier than normal. As the name suggests, pre-emergent is targeted towards newly germinated weeds that have not yet emerged from the soil. It targets over 30 different types of weeds, most notably crabgrass and goosegrass.

We are also progressing with our selective tree thinning project of targeted problem areas that have contributed to the inability to maintain healthy turf and have caused major topsoil depletion. As spring arrives, we will address those areas by adding needed topsoil and sod/seed.
