Dear Valued Members,

I hope everyone who participated in the Kick-Off Classic and cookout had an enjoyable experience. I truly enjoyed setting the pin placements and getting the opportunity to play! The cookout and live music were fantastic as well!

As the course continues to green up, we will be focusing on getting the course dialed in. Over this next month you should be able to see noticeable improvements that will last for years to come. We will continue to make incremental adjustments and improvements throughout the summer.

I would like to address the subject that I probably get the most questions about. GREEN SPEED. We have been conservative with the height-of-cut coming out of winter and throughout the early spring. Over the next couple of weeks, we will be lowering the height-of-cut each week until we get to a speed that we feel is fun and fair, but also challenging. By being conservative we have put little to no stress on the newly growing leaf blades and that will allow us to have strong and healthy turf through the summer and fall.
