Dear Valued Members,

With Fall upon us, the growth of the bermuda grass will begin to slow down and soon become dormant. During the Fall, Winter and early Spring, wear and tear from cart traffic has a major negative effect on the turfgrass. To protect the turfgrass around and near the greens we will be installing signs anywhere from 20-50 yards in front of all Par 4 and Par 5 greens. The signs will direct carts to return to the cart path at that 90 degree point and stay on the path through the next tee box. Par 3s are always cart path only and we ask that when playing a Par 3 that carts always remain on the path. In addition, if you are playing a different hole and your ball comes to rest anywhere on a Par 3, please do not drive onto the Par 3 to retrieve or hit your ball.

If you are a passenger in a cart, help remind the driver of these cart rules if they are unaware or happen to forget. Handicap flags are available in the pro shop if you need special accommodations. These cart rules are common at most golf courses and by following them we will have higher quality turf in those areas throughout the winter and next year's growing season.
